## Celebrate Salem! Community Art Show Requirements

### Celebrate Salem people, places, or things!

- Open to artists of all ages, whether they live in Salem or not.
- Limit two 2-D artworks and/or one 3-D artwork per artist, subject to space availability.
- All art must be the artist's own original work.
- 2-D artwork must be mounted or framed and ready to hang. Maximum dimensions are 18"wx24"h including frame.
- 3-D artwork will be placed in cases if available. Maximum dimensions are 9"x9"x9".
- The artist's information and artwork information/label must be submitted as required. Instructions are on the form.
- The art show and prizes, including a People's Choice Award, are sponsored by Bill and Ellen Arnold. Amateurs are eligible for all prizes. Professional artists are eligible for the People's Choice Award.

### Drop-off and Pick-up

- Register and drop off art on Friday and Saturday, July 6-7, 10 am to 4 pm.
- Works will be placed on display and open to the public on Saturday, July 14. The show closes on September 6.
- Artwork must be picked up on Friday and Saturday, September 7-8 from 10 am to 4 pm unless other arrangements are made.
- The Salem Museum reserves the right to dispose of any artwork that is not picked up according to the published schedule.

### The Fine Print

- The Salem Museum reserves the right to reject any artwork deemed inappropriate for a family-oriented audience.
- By submitting artwork, the artist grants permission to the Salem Museum to use an image of the work for promotional purposes in any and all media.
- The artist assumes all the risks of damage or loss, by any cause.
- There is no fee to exhibit artwork. Artists who wish to offer their work for sale must arrange the sale directly with the buyer. In case of a sale, the Museum requests the consideration of a 25% donation.
